STARSkate General Information

What's New!

We have made several changes to our payment structure this season. Payment/fundraising options have been divided into 3 tiers. Please review carefully for which tier is the best fit for you and your family. We have also linked our accelerated programming adding in the STAR 1 group and STAR 1 advanced.

STARSkate Fundraising & Registration Dates

Fundraising (Due July 11th, 12th, 13th)

- ALL Fundraising vouchers or CASH must be handed in on or before July 11th, 12th or 13th.
- A registration table will be set up from 5:30-7:00pm at Clareview Arena "A" inside the Centennial Skating Club office for members needing to hand in, or purchase fundraising vouchers. Members not available July 11th to 13th will be required to hand in their CASH or vouchers to Michelle during our JUNE office hours. Tuesdays & Thursdays between 5:30-7:00pm. Fundraising Vouchers will be on sale for \$60.00 for the month of June. Starting July 1st they will increase to \$100.00 each.

Registration

- All skaters will be required to register online (through Uplifter) on or before August 10th. Your Skate Canada/Fliteway Membership will be due at the time of registration. Monthly payments will be processed the 1st of each month starting September 1st.

Just a reminder that fundraising is due on your before July 11, 12, 13th.

September Ice Credits

- Additional Fundraising Vouchers or Program Assistant Time Sheets can be handed into Michelle for ice credits. To receive credit for your September payment, please make sure to submit prior to Aug 21st.

Registration Policies and Procedures Overview

- Fundraising for the 2017-2018 winter season is due on or before July 11th, 12th or 13th.
- Members handing in their fundraising after July 13th will be subject to a **\$50.00** administration fee.
- **Fundraising vouchers are non- refundable and non- transferable.**
- Selling vouchers to another member is not permitted.
- Additional vouchers can be used towards coaching invoices or ice credits and are valued at \$60.00.

Leonard Bakker (Partnering/Harness Lessons)

- Invoicing for Lee will be processed monthly offline through our credit card machine.
- Please hand in the credit card information sheet at the same time as your fundraising vouchers/cash and your skating days intent form.

Packages / Value

- Contracts (packages) are pay 1 price, skate as many days as you would like. Please see parent/skaters handbook for lesson recommendations.

2017-2018 STARSkate Program

STARSkate (Figure Skating)

STARSkate offers athletes of all ages an opportunity to develop fundamental figure skating skills in the areas of ice dance, skating skills, freeskate, and interpretive skating. Unique in Canada, this program teaches figure skating skills in a group, semi-private and private lesson format in a progressive and sequential manner. Skaters have the opportunity to try Skate Canada Tests and compete in local, provincial, national and international level competitions.

Junior STARSkate

This is the starting point for skaters just moving up from the Canskate or the Learn to Figure Skate Program. Skaters entering this program require a base coach(s) and are required to take private/semi-private lessons. Lessons are an additional charge and are paid directly to the professional coach. In the Junior STARSkate Program, athletes will continue to develop all the basic skating fundamentals through our grassroots to champions training system.

Intermediate B STARSkate

This is for skaters that have progressed past a Junior STARSkate level and are capable of handling a more challenging training schedule.

Intermediate A STARSkate

Intermediate A is for skaters who are advanced enough to handle skating some sessions with Senior STARSkate. **Skaters must have approval by the director before registering in Intermediate A.**

Senior STARSkate

Senior STARSkate is an advanced program for higher level skaters. Fliteway provides a comprehensive training schedule suited to meet the needs of both high level test skaters, and those inspiring to reach their full potential competitively. **Skaters must have approval by the director before registering into the Senior program.**

Freeskate and Dance Pairs Program

Offered mornings and Sunday afternoons. Skaters DO NOT require a pair partner to join the Fliteway pairs program. If you are interested in dance or freeskate pairs, please contact Clyde to setup an orientation session.

Coaching Director (Clyde Hammer)

STARSkate Payment/Fundraising Tiers

New Tiered Structure

Bingos have been our primary source of fundraising for the past 15 years. Bingo revenues heavily subsidize a large portion of the STARSkate Program. Over the past few years, bingo profits haven't been as lucrative as in the past, resulting in Fliteway having to work more bingos to meet our subsidy needs. Members choosing not to work their mandatory bingos has also resulted in less revenue for the club. In reference to the above, we have created a 3 tiered fundraising structure. Tier 1 being the most affordable with members choosing to work bingos, volunteer, and participate in additional fundraisers. Tier 2 recognizes busy families and the challenges faced with bingo commitments but will still volunteer and participate in club fundraisers. Tier 3 is for extremely busy families with little or no extra time.

2017-2018 Fundraising / Volunteering

Junior Academy is an accelerated Learn to Figure Skate Program for children under the age of 10. This program is perfect for skaters interested in pursuing competitive skating in the future.
